

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

We encourage authors to submit their thematic session proposal, or abstracts for a paper presentation, poster, work shop, or author meets critic session. All contributions will be in English. We also seek volunteers to serve as panel chairs for those panel open to paper submissions.

Thematic Session Proposal examines some aspect of PTSD. These sessions are broad in scope and endeavor to make the theme of the meeting come alive.

Author Meets Critic Sessions are designed to bring authors of recent books or directors of film or artists together with discussants chosen to provide different viewpoints.

Guidelines for Submitting Session Proposals

Thematic Sessions Proposals must include:

- Working title for the session;
- The topic for the session and brief layman description of the substantive focus;
- Names of individuals who will be speaking at the session (with address, telephone, affiliation and email);
- Collection of abstracts for each paper presenter (each of 150 words);
- Session organizer and chair, including address, telephone, and e-mail information (discussant is optional).

Author/Artist/Director Meets Critics Session proposals must include:

- Name and affiliation of book/film/art creator(s);
- Complete title of the work;
- Publication date and name of publisher, if relevant;
- Brief statement about the work's importance for PTSD;
- Rationale for inclusion on the program; and
- Name and information (address, telephone, affiliation and email) for critics and session organizer.

Paper or Poster Presentation proposals must include:

- Name and affiliation of author(s) (address, telephone, affiliation and email);
- Title of paper/poster;
- Abstract of 150 words;
- Three to five keywords;
- Please indicate willingness to be a session chair.

Workshop

- Working title for the workshop;
- Proposed audience, persons of interest
- The topic for the session and brief layman description of the substantive focus;
- Names of individuals who will be speaking at the workshop (with address, telephone, affiliation and email);
- Session organizer and chair, including address, telephone, and e-mail information;
